CHALLENGES

In 2015, SBC was placed on academic probation by SACSCOC and was facing closure. Dr. Drake was appointed by the Supreme Court of the Commonwealth of Virginia due to his expertise in finance, enrollment management & accreditation.

RESULTS

The College has avoided any committee visits from SACSCOC after the closure due to the leadership of the Board of Trustees of which Dr. Drake is a part. SBC now has an enrollment exceeding 375 students from the date of closure and is expected to exceed 500 students for the following academic year.

Dr. Drake now chairs the enrollment management committee and also sits on the finance & audit. and the Academic Affairs committees.
